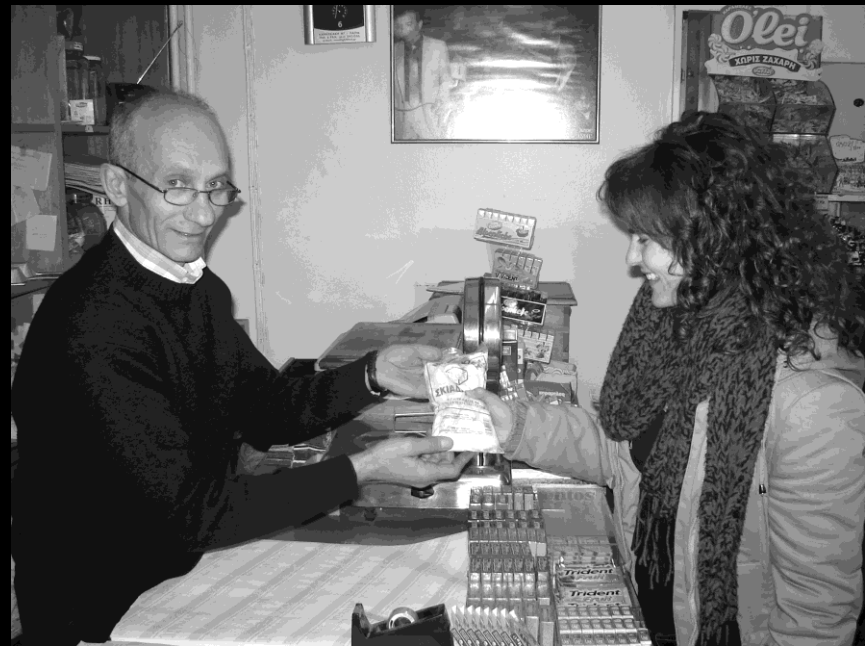

KITCHEN GARDENING



Perpendicular planting for growing on garlic, strawberry and basil

Vertical plants, stacked on top of each other, make use of the building's height.

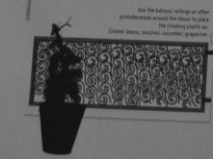
Lighten the vegetables in your balcony inside pots or beds of soil to get plenty of light. Pay attention to the plants' companionship chart. In balcony (in soil), we cannot have both tomatoes and cucumbers, or potatoes and onions available, supported with a neighbor and eating.

If you use beds of soil to plant tomatoes, you need to have a bed of 50 centimeters between plants. In balconies, however, you can plant partially shaded (under pergola or other outdoor awnings). Use gloves to

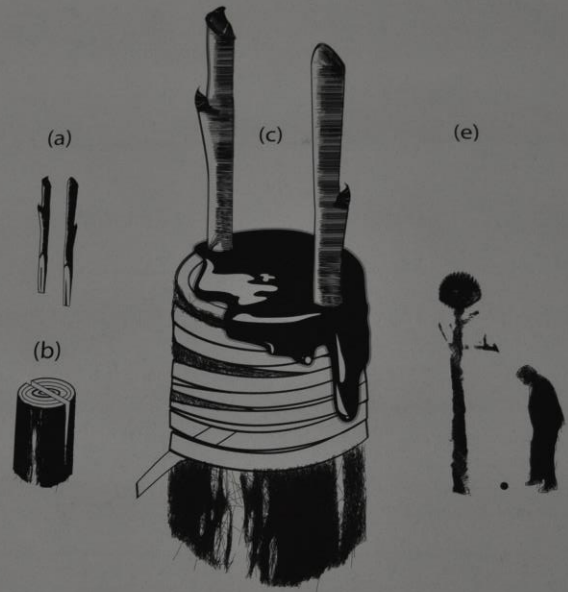

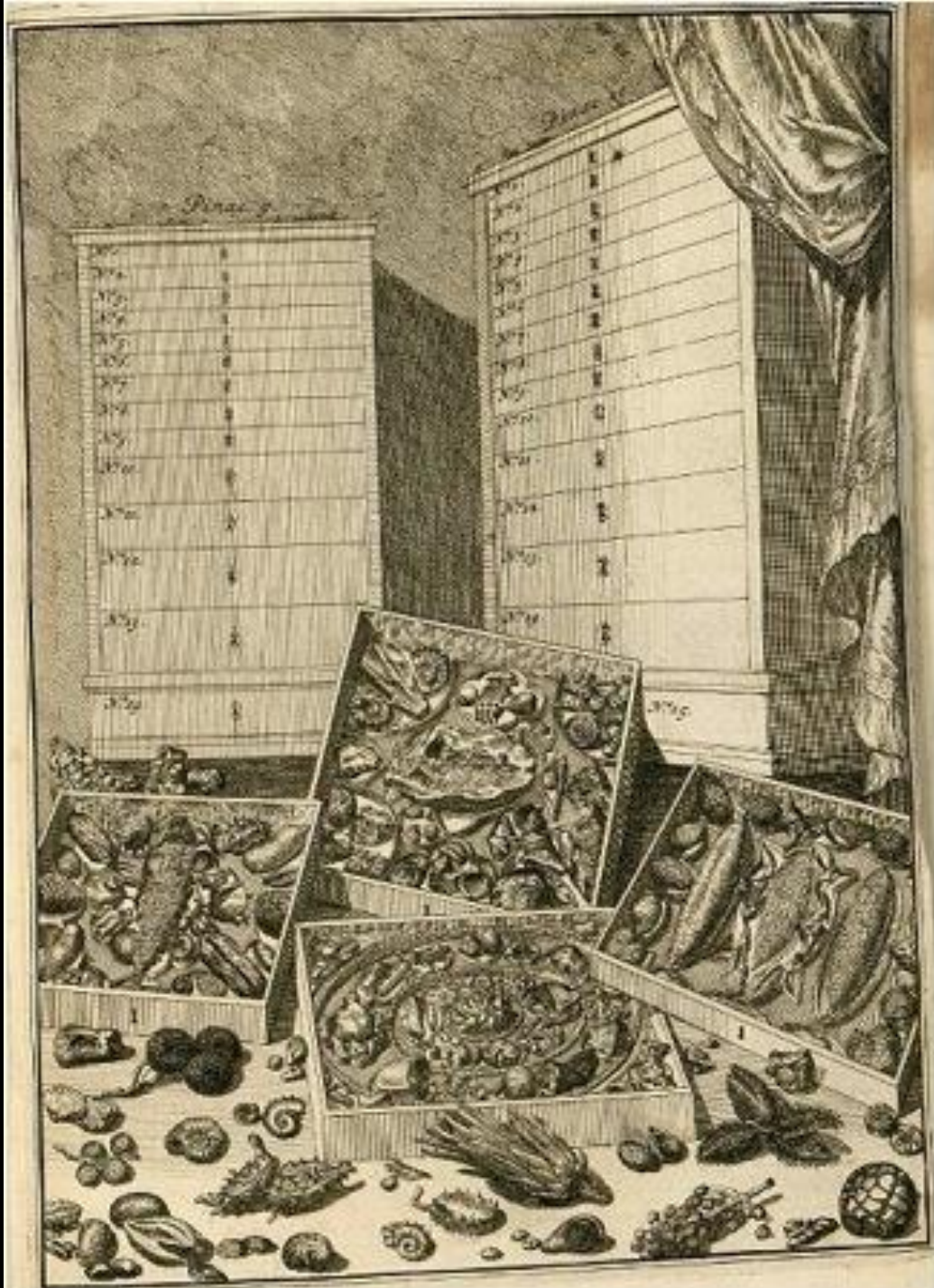
